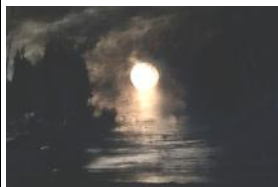

FUNCTIONAL FITNESS MOTs

The Functional Fitness MOTs are fitness tests designed for Over-60s who may be beginning to be worried about falling. We expect each attendee to be with us for about 2 hours. Each person is invited to do the MOT, which is a one-to-one consultation measuring aspects of strength, balance, mobility and endurance against "normal" for their age. Most people find that they are "normal" in some tasks but may be below normal for certain things e.g. strength. They can then think of ways to improve their strength. It takes about 45 minutes but most of that is just chatting! As well as the MOT, we are offering a 30 minute exercise taster, delivered by Dan Lewis from SpArC leisure centre, a film and talk about general Falls Prevention and, of course, a cup of tea!
