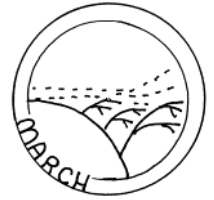

GET OSBORNE - OK, we all know that **Michael Caine** was the star of **Get Carter**, but not a lot of people know that there are those in Clun who are ardent fans of the real star of the film - **John Osborne**. Osborne, who spent his later years living in Shropshire was *'The Angry Young Man'* who wrote *'Look Back in Anger'* - which made a huge impact on British theatre, film and tv. He'd started out as a young actor working in Rep - in his early days he trod the boards at the Playhouse in Kidderminster. After establishing himself as a successful playwright Osborne was persuaded back to his thespian roots by director Mike Hodges in 1971 to play the part of gangster Cyril Kinnear - a frighteningly sinister Mr Big... ('often attributed to Caine, this quote has now been credited as the work of Peter Sellers.)
