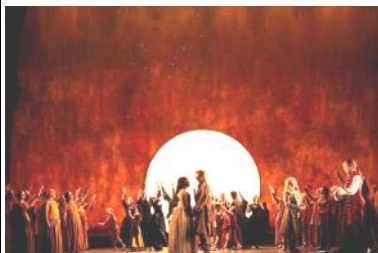


**The Worlds most Spectacular Operas: Carmen On The Lake**
